

Please note! Temporary lease agreement due to renovation work.

The SSH intends to extensively renovate the three high-rise buildings at the Tuindorp-West Complex. We are combining sustainability measures with major maintenance. The start date for the renovation work on the building where this room is located (the red building) is set. Residents can continue to live in the red building until October 15, 2024, at the latest.

If you become the new tenant of this room, you will receive a temporary lease agreement until October 15. You can terminate your contract at any time with one month's notice. The SSH does not provide assistance in finding alternative accommodation. By accepting the lease contract, you confirm that you are aware of the planned renovation work and the end date of your contract (no later than) October 15, 2024.

- You share the unit with up to 10 housemates with shared facilities.
- The gross rental price of the rooms is approximately €361 per month.
- The surface area of the rooms is approximately 13.6 m².
- The rooms are equipped with IPTV (internet and television).
- The room can be terminated with a month notice

You'll find over 1200 fellow students in the Tuindorp-West Complex (TWC) in Utrecht. Even though the old-fashioned flats date all the way back to the 1970s, they're incredibly cheap to rent! That being said, you'll be at Utrecht Overvecht station within the blink of an eye, cycle to the city in less than ten minutes and find yourself all the way in Utrecht Science Park after a 20-minute bike ride.

TWC consists of a total of eight buildings spread over four streets: the Van Lieflandlaan, Gisbert Bromlaan, Frits Coerslaan and the Willem Schuylburglaan.
